As you fast and pray, ask God to help you deny the flesh, discipline your desires, and fully surrender to the power and presence of the Holy Spirit. Let us seek God sincerely, pursue Him passionately, and trust Him boldly like never before in this brand-new season.

FASTING 101

What Is Fast?

- Fasting is a deliberate abstinence from physical gratification for a period to achieve a spiritual purpose. It is a denial of the flesh to say yes to the Spirit. Typically, food is the object of a fast. However, it can apply to other things as well. A believer can fast from TV, social media, or any number of things that our flesh desires. The commitment to fast allows us to focus on God by removing things we normally enjoy and replacing them with Prayer and Bible study. Scripture describes the fasting of numerous individuals including Jesus (Matthew 4:2), Ezra (Ezra 8:21-23, Samuel (1 Samuel 7:6), Daniel (Daniel 1:12), Paul (Acts 9:9), among many others. Jesus communicated the importance of fasting for spiritual breakthroughs to the disciples in Matthew 17:21 when He said, “This kind does not go by but by prayer and fasting.”

FASTING Guidelines

Here are some important things to remember:

***Important exceptions: Use your discretion along with the advice of your physician and prayer to modify the Fast to adhere to your medical needs.**

Anyone with a medical condition related to eating or under the treatment of a Physicians should consult their doctor before proceeding. Also, if you have extreme difficulty with the fast, such as an impairment of your ability to work at your job, you will need to adjust to meet your personal needs. Utilize wisdom, seek the Lord, and discuss it with other Christians involved in the fast, to find alternatives.

*** Water: Drink 6-8 glasses of water daily throughout the fast. This is especially important.**

*** You may experience moderate to severe headaches for the first day or two as Your body rids itself of various impurities. You may need to take Advil or aspirin. If your doctor has advised against Advil or aspirin, please contact your doctor for an alternative.**

***After the fast, ease your way back into following your typical diet.**

FASTING Schedule

We are delighted that you have made the decision to join us on this journey. This fast consists of 3 primary areas: **Food, Finances, and Focus**. To make fasting accessible to all, we have created 3 options. Be led by God and **SELECT A LEVEL THAT WILL WORK FOR YOUR COMMITMENT**. ***Please consult with your primary care physician before making any changes to your diet.**

Option 1: **The Progressive Fast**. If you participate in this fast option, the level of intensity will increase each week.

Option 2: **The Partial Fast**. If you participate in this level, choose a fasting option that you will stick with for the entire time from 6am-6pm daily. This commitment level allows you to be more flexible to your needs.

Option 3: **The Personal Fast**. If you have health concerns, or choose not to fast from food, make a commitment to participate in the Financial and Focus areas of the fast.

Progressive FAST

(If you are unable to intensify each week, maintain a safe and appropriate fasting level in consultation with your medical provider)

Week 1

Food: Participate in the Ezra Fast: Abstain from all sodas and sweets (desserts, pies, cakes, candy, etc.). Natural sweeteners and sugars are okay. Abstain from dairy products and alcohol.

Purpose of this fast: Fasting to solve problems and to seek protection from the evil one.

Finances: Review/obtain your credit score and credit report(annualcreditreport.com). Create a plan to eliminate unnecessary debt.

Focus: Limit non-essential digital communication to two hours a day. Replace this time with prayer and study of God's Word.

Week 2

Food: Participate in the Samuel Fast: Abstain from all types of fried foods and breads.

Purpose of this fast: Fasting to win people to Christ and to get God to pour Himself out on humankind; fasting so that the needs of others will be met and fasting for a stronger testimony and influence.

Finances: Abstain from spending money on non-essential personal items (extra clothing, electronics, etc.)

Focus: Limit TV, movies, and gaming to 2 hours a day. Replace this time with prayer and study of God's Word.

Week 3

Food: Participate in the Daniel Fast: Only consume: Whole Grains, Fruits, Nuts, Beans, Legumes, Vegetables, 100% Fruit Juice, and Water

Purpose of this fast: Fasting for good health and for obedience toward God.

Finances: Abstain from spending money on non-essential daily routine purchases (Cup of coffee, lunch, candy, etc).

Focus: Limit social media Browsing for personal pleasure for 2 hours a day. Replace this time with prayer and study of God's Word.

Week 4

Food: Participate in the St. Paul fast: Consume only water, 100% juice, and broth from 6 am-6 pm. Continue with the Daniel fast in the evenings.

Purpose of this fast: Fasting for wisdom and insight from God.

Daniel Fast purpose: Fasting for good health and for obedience toward God.

Finances: Create a monthly budget and follow the 10-10-80 principle: Tithe 10%, Save 10%, and Live off the remaining 80%. Abstain from credit card purchases.

Focus: No distractions: An entire week of silence. No non-essential texting, or phone calls outside of business, no non-essential social media scrolling. This week is purely devoted to hearing the voice of God speak in silence.

Prayer Guidelines

During this season, as a church family, we encourage you to have a daily quiet time where you seek the Lord through prayer and meditation on His Word. **Mark 1:35 says about Jesus, “Now in the morning, having risen a long while before daylight, He went out and departed to a solitary place; and there He prayed.”** In your daily quiet time, set aside 15-20 minutes to apply the 3 P’s:

1. **Pray**- Start off by simply being still and quiet before God. Then pray, asking God to give you clarity, focus, and discernment as you read His Word.
2. **Passage**- Let God speak to you by reading the selected Bible passage for the day or any portion of scripture that God leads you to. Read the passage slowly and meditate on what God is saying to you. Write down what you believe God is saying to you.
3. **Praise**- End your time by thanking God for speaking to you in His Word. Praise Him through the daily song or simply praise Him as the Spirit leads you.

Other disciplines during the 21 days

1. Make a commitment to get on the **Prayer Call** at least 1x a week.
 2. Participate in **WOW Bible Study** on Wednesdays at 6:00 to be encouraged as we study the power and principles of prayer.
 3. Participate in **Sunday School**
