Message: **Put a Praise on it!**

Scripture text: **Ephesians 3:14-21**

Key Take-away: When passionate prayer meets God's power, it ought to produce praise!

G (Grow through the Word)

1. What kind of strength does Paul pray for believers to experience and where does it come from? v.16
2. How can Christ's love keep believers stable when life around them is unstable? Ephesians v. 17-18
3. Why should remembering what God is able to do change the way we pray and praise? v.20-21

P (Prayerfully ponder)

1. What situation am I facing that I need to stop measuring by my ability and start measuring by what God is able to do?
2. Paul ends his prayer by giving God glory. How can I "Put a praise on it" and give God glory while I am still waiting for Him to answer my prayer?

S (Serve)

Praise should not end with our lips; it should influence how we live.

This week:

Strengthen someone who may be tired, discouraged, or struggling by sharing your praise. Tell them one thing God has done, is doing, or that you are trusting Him to do.

Prayer:

Dear Heavenly Father, we bow before You recognizing that You are the source of our strength, our stability, and our satisfaction. Strengthen us through Your Spirit in our inner being. When life feels uncertain, root us and ground us in the unfailing love of Christ. Dear Lord, help us to know the love of Christ so that we may experience the fullness of God. Forgive us for the times we have allowed the size of our problems to make us forget the greatness of our God. We believe You are able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to Your power that is already at work within us. So, before we see the answer, we will put a praise on it! Before the door opens, we will praise You. Before the situation changes, we will praise You. Before we understand how You will work it out, we will praise You because we know that You are able!

Now unto You be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever.
