Message: **What to do when your Back is against the Wall!**

Scripture text: **Isaiah 38:1-3;19**

Key Take-away: When our backs are against the wall, that's the time to turn to God not from God!

G (Grow through the Word)

1. What kind of king was Hezekiah? 2 Kings 18:3-7
2. What painful pronouncement did Hezekiah receive? Isaiah 38:1
3. How did Hezekiah respond when his back was against the wall? Isaiah 38:2-3
4. What did God do in response to Hezekiah's prayer? Isaiah 38:4-6
5. According to Hezekiah, what should those who have experienced God's faithfulness do? Isaiah 38:19

P (Prayerfully ponder)

1. What challenge are you or someone you know facing that requires you to pray both focusedly and fervently?
2. Am I living my life in a way that gives God something worth remembering?

S (Serve)

Hezekiah declared, **"The living, the living, he shall praise thee"** (Isaiah 38:19). God's faithfulness should produce praise and it should also move us to action. This week, turn your testimony into service. Encourage someone whose back is against the wall. Pray with them, share how God has been faithful to you, or offer practical help that reminds them they are not facing their struggle alone.

Prayer:

Dear Heavenly Father,

Thank You for reminding me that when my back is against the wall, I can still turn my face toward You. When I receive difficult news, face impossible circumstances, or cannot see a way forward, help me not to turn away from You in fear, frustration, or doubt. Give me the courage to believe that You are still God even when I cannot see what You are doing. When my back is against the wall, teach me to turn to You, trust in You, and testify about You.
